- \* Please call the race office if you have a question. Only 2 people allowed in the race office at one time.
- \* NO DOUBLE CLASS DROPS UNLESS APPROVED BY RACE OFFICE. WILL ONLY BE USED IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.
- \* All races may be considered sub races.
- \* When possible races will be split by sex.
- \* All trainers stabled on the grounds must be on the grounds 24 hours before the day of the race or your horse will be scratched and you may be fined.
- \*Horses winning Track Master Race must move up to the next level for three (3) starts.
- \*You are allowed 3 wins per Track Master condition.
- \*When possible the last race nightly will have 9 horses in it. The sixth place finisher will receive a \$100 stipend.
- \*In the paddock each horse is allowed 1 groom, 1 trainer, and 1 driver.
- \* Stable roster sheets must be completed, up-to-date at all times, and on file in the race office.
