<sup>\*</sup>Horses that made their last start outside of WNY may only drop ONE comparable class unless approved by the race office.

<sup>\*</sup>No triple class drops unless approved by the race office. Will only be used in emergency situations.

<sup>\*</sup> All races may be considered sub races.

<sup>\*</sup> When possible races will be split by sex.

<sup>\*</sup> All trainers stabled on the grounds must be on the grounds 24 hours before the day of the race or your horse will be scratched and you may be fined.

<sup>\*</sup>When possible the last race nightly will have 9 horses in it. The sixth place finisher will receive a \$100 stipend.

<sup>\*</sup> Stable roster sheets must be completed, up-to-date at all times, and on file in the race office.

<sup>\*</sup>If you need a repair to your barn/stalls, please fill out a work request form in the race office,

<sup>\*</sup>Batavia Downs has a 60 day claiming rule.

<sup>\*</sup>Scratch Policy - Effective immediately - Any horse scratched from post position 8 at any track, at any time, will not be permitted to enter at Batavia Downs for 7 days from the date of scratch. No exceptions unless approved by racing management.
